What is a RCG?

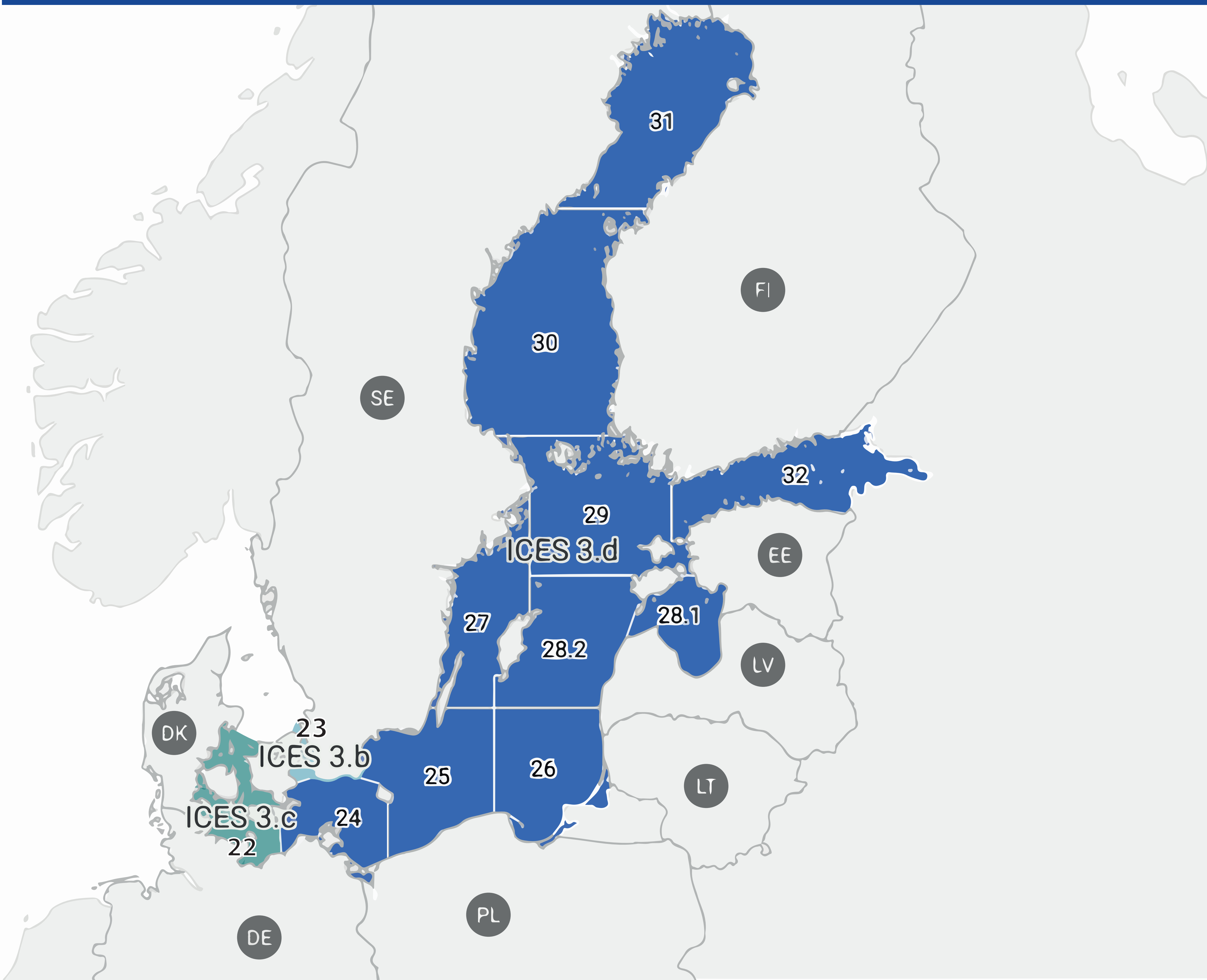
It is the main hub for regional coordination and cooperation within the different sea basins or specific types of fisheries contributing to the EU Fisheries Data Collection Framework.
